The HSLIC Envoy service offers a personalized approach to assist departments and individuals with their information and research needs. HSLIC faculty members are individually assigned to units, departments and colleges throughout the HSC. Envoys serve as the first person to call for their designated units. They will consult, coordinate and collaborate to support health sciences scholarship, evidence-based practice and research.

- Assist with data/information management planning
- Take your requests for changes to our collections of books, journals and scholarly publications
- Help you look for Open Access course materials in repositories
- Help you select materials for course reserves
