

Where to Study

- **Library** — You may reserve any of the library’s seven study rooms at least 24 hours in advance for group study. Go to <http://hslc.unm.edu> and click on the Featured Link titled “Reserve Study Rooms.”
- **Domenici Center** — Seven group study rooms are available in the Domenici Center on a first-come, first-served basis. Students can also gain access to the 24/7 student lounge in the Domenici Center’s east building with their student IDs.

For Your Comfort and Convenience

- **Electronics and other resources for checkout** — Laptop computers, iPads, headphones, a portable AV set with a microphone, an audio recorder, a digital timer, dry-erase marker sets and a variety of anatomical models
- **Walking treadmills** — Library, 3rd floor
- **Mothers’ rooms** — On the 3rd floor of the library and on the lower level of the west building of the Domenici Center
- **Charging stations** — In the lobby of the main (2nd) floor of the library, in the Collaboratory (group study area) on the 3rd floor of the library and in the student lounge in the east building of the Domenici Center

Refreshments

Food and drinks are allowed in the HSLIC and Domenici Center buildings. Vending machines are located on HSLIC’s main (2nd) floor. Here are nearby locations where you can buy drinks, snacks and hot food:

- **Espresso Café** — Located in the basement of the Domenici Center. Open 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

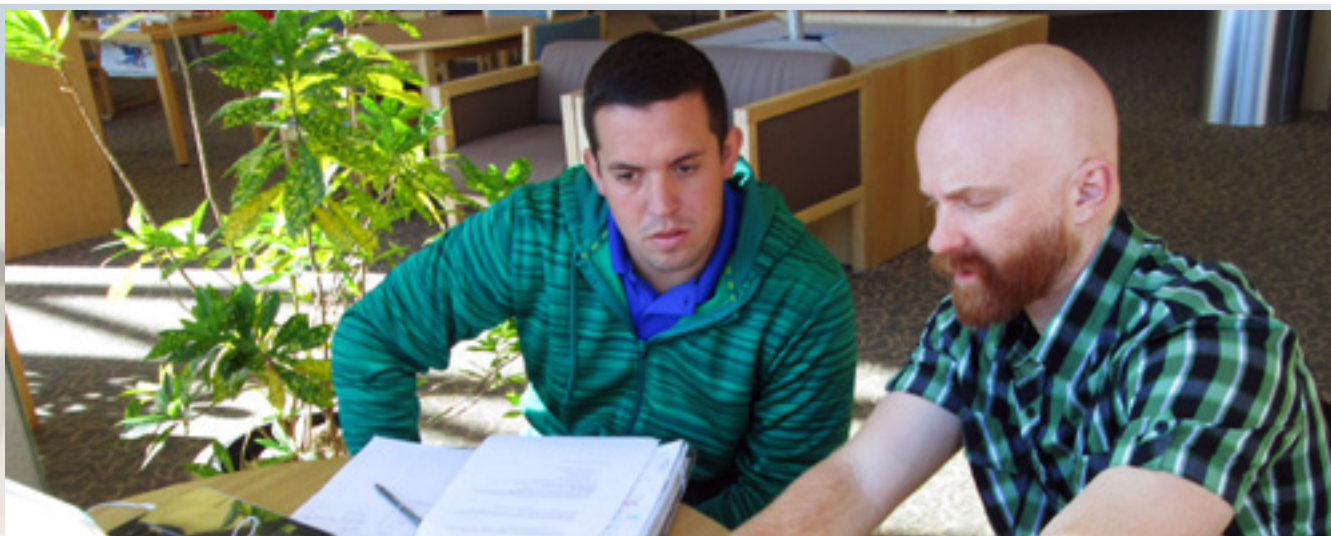

The Health Sciences Library and Informatics Center

We provide the following services to the Health Sciences Center (HSC) community:

- **Tech support** — Help syncing your smartphone or device to the HSC email system (Outlook/HSCLink) at the Service Point
- **Study areas** — For individual or group study
- **Resources** — Online resources, plus print resources and anatomical models to check out and use in the library
- **Historical collections** — For your research: primary source collections that document the history of health care in New Mexico, oral histories, and out-of-print and rare books

Wireless Access

The HSC has two wireless networks:

- **HSC_Secure** — For access to HSC resources that are available only on campus (e.g., SharePoint and password resetting). Log in with your HSC NetID and password.
- **HSC_Guest** — This wireless network is like the network you would use at any public hot spot.

Library Resources

On our website (<http://hslic.unm.edu>), access subject guides, thousands of eJournals and eBooks, plus more than 100 databases covering medicine and health-related disciplines.

- **Course reserves** — A tool for finding reserved materials using the “Course Reserves” link in the WorldCat tab on our home page
- **eBooks** — Thousands of titles, such as *Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine*
- **eJournals** — Thousands of full-text journal subscriptions, including titles such as *The New England Journal of Medicine* and *The Lancet*
- **Databases** — *Bates' Guide to Physical Examination*, *Acland's Video Atlas of Anatomy*, etc.
- **PubMed** — Searchable citations and abstracts from MEDLINE and other life sciences journals
- **Point-of-care tools** — UpToDate, ACP Smart Medicine, ClinicalKey, etc.
- **Drug information databases** — Micromedex, Lexicomp and Clinical Pharmacology
- **Zotero** — A tool to help you manage your references and create bibliographies
- **Exam Master & Board Vitals** — Prep for USMLE, NAPLEX, PANCE, NCLEX and dental exams

- **Subject guides** — 40 subject guides on topics like nursing resources, Zotero, physical therapy resources and radiologic sciences/nuclear medicine
- **WorldCat** — A searchable database of books, journals, articles and more
- **UNM Libraries** — Main-campus libraries: Zimmerman, Parish, Fine Arts and Centennial Science and Engineering Library (<http://www.unm.edu/libraries.html>)

Interlibrary Loan and Document Delivery

HSC faculty, staff and students receive free document delivery via email and interlibrary loan services. Request items from the library's catalog or click on the Interlibrary Loan link on HSLIC's home page.
