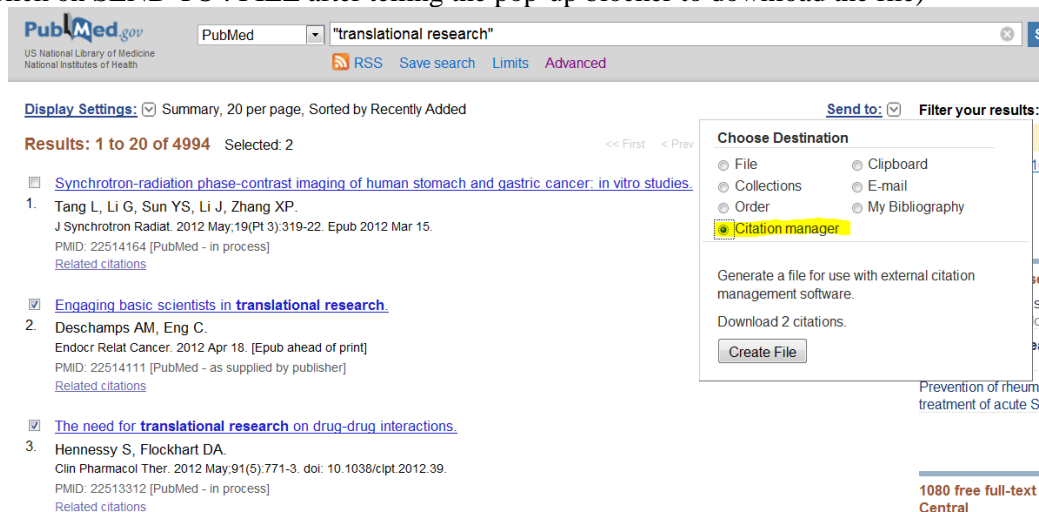
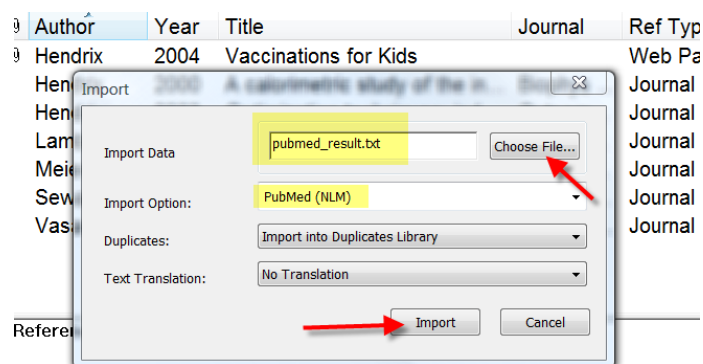



Capturing Citations from PubMed into EndNote X5

1. While in PubMed, select the citations you wish to download. Click on **SEND TO** on the right and select **Citation Manager**. Click on Create File. Follow the dialog box instructions that appear and save the file to your desktop. (**Note:** if you have pop-up blockers enabled, you will have to click on SEND TO : FILE after telling the pop-up blocker to download the file)



2. Go into EndNote and open the Library to capture the citations into or create a new library.
3. Under the File menu in EndNote, select **Import**, then **File**.
4. At the dialog box that appears, click on **Choose...** to the right of the **Import File** box. Select the location of your file of data you saved from PubMed – it should appear as **citations.nbib**. In the Import Option box, select **Other Filters** if **PubMed(NLM)** does not appear. When the list of filters appears, scroll down the list and select **PubMed(NLM)**. Then click **Choose**. In the Duplicates box, click on the right arrow and select **Discard Duplicates** or whichever preference you wish. In the **Text Translation** box, leave the default setting of **No Translation**. Then click on the **Import** button at the bottom of the box.
