## **Research, Teaching and Service Interests**

### **Research**

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My research interests are varied and cover a range of disciplines. Exploring how clinicians, in particular nurses, obtain and manage information in clinical practice informs my service delivery. In collaboration with the UNMH Nursing Research Director, I designed a randomized controlled trial to understand intensive care nurses' access to and incorporation of information. As hypothesized, their information needs are as great as any other health care professional and they share similar barriers to obtaining information – time and skills. As a result of that research, I have partnered with the UNMH Nursing Research Director and Nursing Research Council to develop easy and accessible methods to connect nurses to the information they need for patient care. Another area of interest is in developing optimal learning systems for students in the health sciences to develop lifelong learning skills related to information seeking and management. Developing and evolving more robust curricula in information competencies is an area of research I continue to explore in my collaborative work in the School of Medicine Perspectives in Medicine electives. I have expanded my areas of research interest outside of traditional library roles, by partnering with faculty and students of the UNM occupational therapy program. Our collaborations have focused on strengthening the evidence for the use of service dogs for people with disabilities. This has provided me with a unique opportunity to mentor students in research design and presentation and to further expand my relationships with the faculty. I take every opportunity to partner with faculty across the health sciences as these varied collaborative opportunities inform my knowledge of those fields and makes me a more effective librarian in my service to the students and faculty of the Health Sciences Center.

### **Teaching**

As a librarian, I am uniquely positioned to guide students to quality evidence-based resources. In an age of Google and Wikipedia, students rely too readily on what is easy to access with little consideration to their sources. Many of the faculty believe that students are facile in using online resources because of their comfort with technology. But as I and my colleagues know, their critical thinking skills in relation to content is often lacking. Engaging students in interactive learning and peer to peer learning techniques is essential to engaging all types of learners in developing these lifelong learning skills. I am passionate about teaching and am constantly looking for new educational approaches that will stimulate and engage students. I have collaborated extensively with my colleague, Sarah Morley, to develop curricula to address gaps we have seen in student preparedness and knowledge related to information seeking and management. Development and delivery of faculty instruction in information competencies is also key, as these learners are often overlooked but need updated information skills in order to model good behavior for their students and to stay abreast of information in their own fields of interest.

### **Service**

My committee work throughout the health sciences center draws upon my belief that librarians should move outside library walls and meet users in their own environment. Committee work helps me stay connected to the programs I serve and wider campus committee involvement allows me to experience different disciplinary perspectives and expand my understanding of the broader university environment. Another area of interest is advocating for myself and others with disabilities. To that end, I have become involved in campus wide committees to support the work of making UNM a fully accessible campus and using my experience to help students with disabilities navigate through their college experience.
